### **Samstag, den 23. April | Workshop 14 bis 16 Uhr**

"SERPENTINE" mit Valentina Pini und Manon Fantini

How to maintain equilibrium with a collective counterbalance

In this two-hour workshop, participants will test ways to maintain a precarious equilibrium using collective counterbalance. Inspired by the serpentine line, an aesthetic reference that evokes the shape of a snake, we will design a giant equilibrium game in which every participant can optimize or complicate the course of events along with all other players' decisions. The SERPENTINE workshop offers a playful way to think and work collectively while experimenting with a variety of materials.

### **Sonntag, den 24. April | Printing Workshop 15 bis 17 Uhr**

"Rumination", Zine-workshop mit M.Paradoxa

Rumination is a process of chewing on words, digesting them deeper—implying both a physical and a conceptual act. Inspired by the content from the 2<sup>nd</sup> issue of *S-paper*, this workshop will explore the relationship between "WORDS" and "ACTIONS". We invite participants to engage with *S-paper* by taking a series of simple steps and to create their own printed matter through a DIY silk-screen printing technique.

### **Samstag, den 30. April | hapa zome Workshop 15 bis 18 Uhr**

"Echo of Leaf and Body" mit BadLab (Corinna Mattner, Lisa Biedlingmaier)

During the Echo of Leaf and Body workshop, BadLab will create a collective resonance space through sound and gesture. Participants are invited to contribute and hold the acoustic space together with the vibrations of the gong, readings, and writings—an evolving soundscape through making a DIY structure of healing. Within these sounds, each participant will choose their healing plants intuitively, foraged in the public space surrounding Kunstverein Wagenhalle, to create a personal healing pattern in the form of a hapa zome mandala, inspired by the heritage of Swiss healer Emma Kunz.

### **Samstag, den 7. Mai von 16 bis 19 Uhr**

**Finissage** und Präsentation des Langzeitprojekts „Beijing22“ von tria publishing platform.

Beijing22 is an open, independent, long-term curatorial project, which investigates the urban processes of Beijing in the five years leading up to the Winter Olympic Games in 2022. The project unfolds in the forms of exhibitions, publications, talks, conferences and other activities; thereby collecting different positions and perspectives from artists, curators, academics and journalists from China and abroad, in order to initiate a cultural exchange and discourse on the topic.

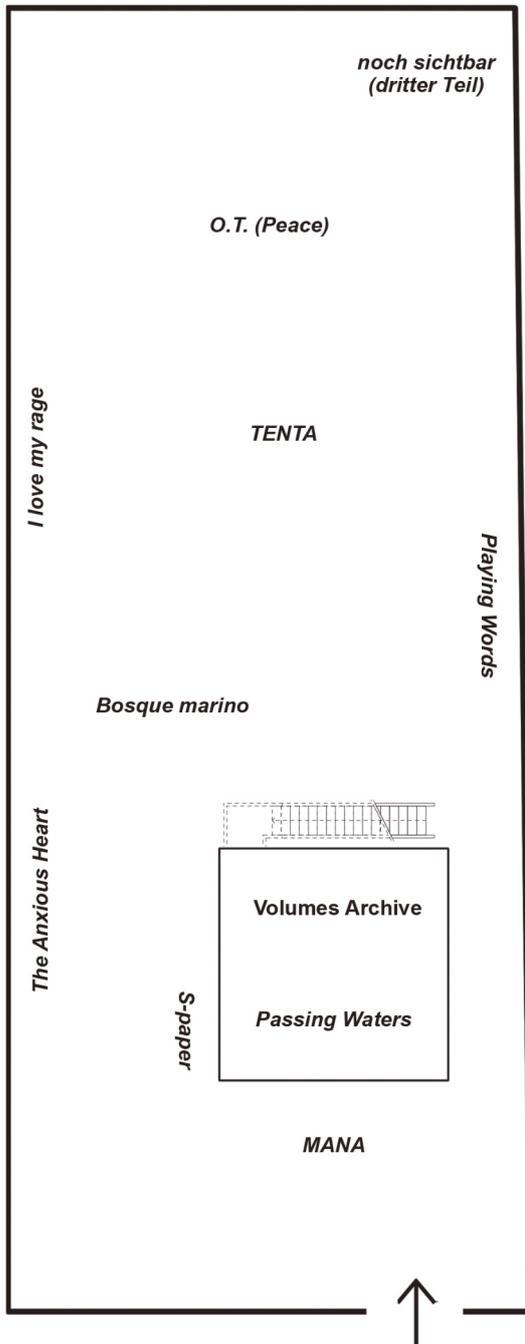
